This diversity allows us to obtain consistent quality across vintages.

Winemaker Comments

You are either a Gewürztraminer fan or not, but you know it when you taste one you like. This vintage has everything we favor in this spicy white while avoiding the cloying richness that can often make these wines too heady. This wine was sourced from vines that were cloned from the Manigold vineyard, one of the Old Mission Peninsula's best vineyards for this variety.

Tasting Notes

Pretty floral aromas of crushed rose petals are followed by notes of rose water, citrus, and candied ginger complemented by a soft finish.

Thoughts for Food

Middle Eastern fare like kebabs, dishes that feature aromatic herbs like ginger, clove, or cinnamon, and traditional roasted turkey.
